**NOTES**

This organ was originally built for the Andover Theological Seminary in Andover, Massachusetts. The Seminary moved to Cambridge in 1908 and the organ was sold to a Baptist Church in Clinton, Connecticut. In 1984 it was acquired by a physician in Middlebury, Connecticut who had intended to set it up in his home, but never did. The organ was placed in storage. It was subsequently relocated thru the Organ Clearing House.

The case is from the ca. 1848 George Stevens from Metropolitan Baptist Church in Roxbury, Massachusetts.

Stops and controls marked with an asterisk (\*) have new/replacement stop labels.
